Adjudicators

Phillida Green

Phillida Green studied at the junior schools of both Juilliard in New York and the Royal College of Music in London, and after a B. Mus degree at Sydney University completed two years of post-graduate study in piano at the Royal Northern College of Music, Manchester. She has performed widely as a soloist, in both England and Italy as well as in Australia, including a number of appearances as soloist with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra and the performance of the complete "Well-tempered Klavier". She has adjudicated at many eisteddfods including the City of Sydney and the National Eisteddfods, and was on the selection panel for the Sydney auditions of the World Power International Piano Competition held in London. Phillida teaches at Ascham School as well as privately in Sydney and was on the staff of Wollongong Conservatorium of Music from 1983 to 2009, as Head of Keyboard from 2008.

Bradley Evans

Bradley Evans musical education commenced in Sydney with Annette Erskine-Smith. He completed his Bachelor of Music degree at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music in 1981, studying with Elizabeth Powell. In 1982 he was the successful state winner and finalist in the Commonwealth for the A.B.C. Concerto Competition. He was also the winner of the Inaugural Yamaha National Piano Competition. The Queen Elizabeth Silver Jubilee Award enabled him to continue his studies in London with Benjamin Kaplan where he was a Prize winner in the Overseas League Competition.

In 1989 he completed his graduate Diploma in Accompaniment at the Sydney Conservatorium, studying with David Miller. From 1991 to 2001 he lived and taught in Germany where he frequently performed in a two piano duo with Hugo Seebach. Since returning to Australia in 2001 Bradley has taught at the Conservatorium Access Centre, St. Catherine's School Waverley, and Sydney Grammar School.

Bradley has a thriving and successful Private Teaching studio, being the recipient of the A.M.E.B. Shield (7th Grade to Diploma) in 2012.

Dr. Mark Griffiths

Dr. Mark Griffiths has established a distinguished portfolio career in teaching, examining, adjudication and music research. He is a graduate of Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University, where he has been a tertiary and pre-tertiary lecturer for twenty-five years. His professional activities are informed by ongoing reflective practice with cohorts from early childhood to postgraduate level. His current focus areas are one-to-one piano pedagogy, group teaching and teacher mentoring. Mark's doctoral research, completed in 2017, investigated pedagogical strategies used to foster expressive performance skills within pre-tertiary pianists. Dr. Griffiths has led piano masterclasses in Queensland and Victoria and enjoys sharing his ideas and experiences with students and their teachers, speaking at pedagogy symposia, and adjudicating competitions and eisteddfodau across Australia.
