Under the APRA AMCOS licence, competitors will not be allowed to perform without this form being filled out.

#### What is AMCOS?

The Australasian Mechanical Copyright Owners Society (AMCOS) ensures composers/songwriters and publishers receive royalties for the reproduction of their musical works. In turn, AMCOS provides music users to legally play, perform, copy, record and make available their members' music.

#### What is copyright?


Australian copyright law is legislated at a Federal level by the Australian parliament and is contained in the Commonwealth Copyright Act 1968. In simple terms, copyright is rights given to creators of original works and recordings that include exclusive rights to reproduce the material and the right to perform the work to the public. Copyright owners can prevent others from reproducing or performing their work without their permission.

#### **General Rules and Conditions**

Please Note: All rules must be read carefully to avoid disappointment and possible disqualification. Rules and conditions that apply in 2023.

#### **APPLICATIONS**

- 1. Please refer to the "How to Enter Online" tab for more information
- 2. Payments are to be made to the St. George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. Please click here for more information
- 3. All entries must be completed online. No entry will be accepted unless the online entry process is followed. Click here for more information.
- 4. An incomplete online entry will not be accepted. All sections of the online application process must be completed.
- 5. Entries must be submitted online no later than 1st May 2023.
- 6. Any late entry submitted after the 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023. Will incur an extra \$25.00 for each entry. Late entries will not be accepted after 9<sup>th</sup> May 2023.
- 7. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. holds no responsibility for any incorrect details submitted.
- 8. An entry acknowledgement receipt with your ID number for reference will be emailed to the email address provided by you. Competitors must contact if they have not received this email within 14 days of lodgement.
- 9. Any changes and/or corrections of details or sections WILL NOT be permitted after 9<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Competitors are advised to check all details emailed to them carefully. Any request for changes and/or corrections of details, which are the fault of the applicant, must be accompanied by a \$10.00 administration fee per each change or correction. Please check your application form thoroughly before submitting.
- 10. Competitors may NOT appear in section(s) other than those specified in their accepted entry form. The Committee has the right to refuse an entry.

#### **AGE LIMITS**

- 11. Competitors must perform in events applicable to their age only, unless an event has all ages specified. Age is determined as at 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023.
- 12. Events titled ANY AGE are open to anyone.
- 13. Events titled "Restricted" are only open to competitors who have not been placed 1st or 2nd in that Restricted section, in that particular age group, in a prior St George Instrumental Eisteddfod.

#### **EVENTS AND PERFORMANCES**

14. The adjudicator's decision is final.

- 15. The Convenor has the right to combine, divide sections, or reduce the number of prizes depending on the number of performing competitors. The Convenor's decision is final.
- 16. There must be a minimum of three (3) competitors performing in each section. In the event of fewer than 3 competitors performing, each competitor will receive an adjudication report only and no trophies or monetary prizes will be awarded.
- 17. Competitors must register AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE the start of the event. Competitors who fail to do so will receive adjudication reports only and will not be eligible for any trophies or monetary prizes. It is advised that when travelling to the Eisteddfod venue on competition days, each competitor should allow time for transport delays and/or parking.
- 18. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. accepts no responsibility for any unauthorised photocopy of music used by competitors. Please refer to the copyright laws of the Australian Commonwealth Agencies.
- 19. A competitor must provide at the registration table on the day of performance, a copy of the Competitor's "own choice" music for the use of the Adjudicator. PLEASE NOTE: Any photocopied music will not be returned and will be destroyed. Commercially printed sheet music provided will be returned.
- 20. Choosing the correct music/style according to each section's requirement as stipulated by the syllabus, is the responsibility of each competitor. Failure to present with the correct music will result in an adjudication report only. Only one (1) piece of music is allowed per section. You are not permitted to play the same piece of music in more than one section.
- 21. Competitors and their parents/supporters may not approach the Adjudicator's table, nor speak to the Adjudicator. If these rules are ignored, the competitor will be disqualified immediately.
- 22. Where a time limit is set for a performance, the competitor should not exceed it. Should this happen, the competitor is disqualified for a prize and will receive a report only.
- 23. Competitors in championship sections must compete in at least THREE SECTIONS in the 2023 St George Instrumental Eisteddfod, one of which is the championship itself. The pieces performed for the championship must not have been performed from the other two (2) or more sections. The pieces played during the heats one piece must be repeated for the finals (if applicable).
- 24. First place Championship winners are not permitted to enter the same section for the next two (2) years.
- 25. Persons who have been taught or advised by the Adjudicator in the six (6) months prior to the opening day of the Eisteddfod cannot compete in the Eisteddfod under that adjudicator.
- 26. Competitors waiting their turn and audience members will show consideration by remaining quiet while others are competing. If continual disruption is generated during a performance, the offender will be asked leave the room until that particular Section has been completed.

27. Mobile phones and other electronic devices must be switched off upon entering the hall.

#### OTHER

- 28. Copyright laws and Child Protection legal requirements prohibit private use of mobile phones, cameras, laptops, iPads, tablets and any other electronic recording devices in the competition area of the Eisteddfod venue. If a competitor's parents/supporters are found using such items any time within the performance hall, the child will be disqualified from the particular section of the competition in which they are appearing. Any offender will be asked to leave the competition area.
- 29. The Eisteddfod reserves the right to record, film, broadcast, telecast, videotape or photograph any entrant, item or event in the Eisteddfod without notification and any such photograph, recording or broadcast may be used at the Eisteddfod's discretion for publicity or promotional purposes, but shall not necessarily constitute an endorsement of any participants, and no remuneration or compensation whatsoever shall be attributable to any participants so featured.
- 30. The Eisteddfod, at its sole discretion, may promote or publicise the profile of any entrant and their participation and publish names and competition results, including photos via electronic and printed media at its discretion.
- 31. Personal details provided by an entrant on the entry form are for the Eisteddfod identification use only and are not released to third parties except at the Eisteddfod's discretion after consultation with the entrant to known organisations when an opportunity may be beneficial to an entrant.
- 32. Large bags, for example BACKPACKS, SCHOOL BAGS, INSTRUMENT CARRYING CASES ARE TO BE LEFT AT THE REGISTRATION AREA. These types of items are not permitted in the competition area of the Eisteddfod.
- 33. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. wishes to advise we are not responsible for any accident, injury, and/or loss of property. Please be responsible for your own personal items when attending the St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc.
- 34. All protests must be in writing and handed in within one hour of the completion of a section, accompanied by a fee of \$50.00. The fee is forfeited if the protest is dismissed.
- 35. Disruptive behaviour and/or the consumption of liquor is not acceptable nor allowed in the eisteddfod venue. This rule applies to all people who are attending the Eisteddfod venue. The offending person/people will be asked to leave immediately.
- 36. Admission to the competition area is to be made by Card only at the main entrance of the Kogarah School of Arts. See our website prior to attending the Eisteddfod for entry fees.
- 37. Competitors entering sections P202, P208, P217 and P230 are only eligible to enter one graded section only.
- 38. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. does not provide instruments other than the piano(s) for any section. If a competitor requires another instrument other than the piano, they must provide their own instruments.

39. Failure to comply with any of the foregoing rules and conditions may cause withholding of prizes, disqualification, and/or a future bar. The decision of the Eisteddfod in all questions or disputes arising out of or not provided for by these rules and regulations will be final. All entries are received according to this condition and in the spirit of friendly competition upon which the Eisteddfod is based, and no dispute shall become the subject of any appeal at law.

#### **STRINGS**

- 40. All the rules and conditions above apply to the String divisions.
- 41. Competitors entering sections ST312, ST325 and ST330 are only eligible to enter one graded section only.
- 42. Competitors who enter Open age String Concerto Championship (ST333) must compete in at THREE SECTIONS in the 2023 St George Instrumental Eisteddfod, one of which is the championship itself. The pieces performed for the championship must not have been performed from the other two (2) or more sections. The pieces played during the heats one piece must be repeated for the finals (if applicable).
- 43. The first placed Championship Winner is not permitted to enter the same section for the next two (2) years.
- 44. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. does not provide an official accompanist for any section. Each competitor must provide their own accompanist both for rehearsals and for the performance itself. Failure to provide an accompanist does disadvantage the performance and will result in a competitor not being considered for a prize in that section.
- 45. **NOTE FOR ACCOMPANISTS**: Accompanists are entitled free entry only if an application to the Convenor is received by email one month prior to the opening day of the St George Instrumental Eisteddfod.

## Copyright

It is important that all contestants and teachers realise their responsibility regarding laws under the *Australian Copyright Act 1968*. The following are the conditions under which printed material can be used at this Eisteddfod.

#### **Adjudicator's Copy**

- Own Choice, the competitor must supply the Adjudicator with a photocopy. The original is to be used by the competitor for the performance and the Eisteddfod Committee will destroy the copy immediately after adjudication.
- For Set Pieces, the Adjudicator must work from an original.

#### **Competitor's Copy**

If the competitor is not performing from memory, an original or licensed photocopy must be used in the performance. This original can be borrowed from a library, friend or another competitor.

#### New Rulings on Accompanist's Copy (AMCOS)

The following conditions must be met before a photocopy can be made for an accompanist:

- The accompaniment part must be printed on the same page as the solo instrumental or vocal part(s) i.e. inseparable from the solo part.
- A single photocopy of the accompaniment may be made for use in a performance such as an Eisteddfod.
- Single copy must be marked with the words "Accompanist Copy".

After the performance, the copy of the accompaniment must be handed to the Eisteddfod Organisation for collection and all these copies sent to AMCOS at the conclusion of the Eisteddfod-

#### **Child Protection**

In the interest of protecting children The St. George Eisteddfod Inc requests that photographs / videos of children not be taken in the area of competition.

To take photographs / videos is considered to be an invasion of privacy and the person doing so may be in breach of the Privacy Laws of both the Commonwealth of Australia and The NSW Government Laws within the Privacy Act.

#### **Adjudicators**

#### Mark McGee

Mark McGee is Assistant Director of Music at St. Kevin's College and also teaches piano and lectures in piano pedagogy at Melbourne University's Faculty of Music where he became, in 2002, the first pianist in Australia to have conferred upon him the degree of Doctor of Musical Arts. He is a Federal examiner with the AMEB and is also a qualified teacher of the Alexander Technique.

Mark's experience as a pianist is considerable, and includes concertos with various ABC State Orchestras, numerous solo recitals and performances with some of Australia's most distinguished musicians. He was first prize winner of the inaugural Australian National Piano Award held at Shepparton. His exposure, during his years of study in Europe in the 1980s, to the teaching of pianists Claudio Arrau and Wilhelm Kempff, and the conductor Sergiu Celibidache, has been of central importance to the development of his musical philosophy and ideas about teaching.

#### **Amanda Miller**

Amanda graduated from Sydney Conservatorium with a Bachelor of Music followed by a Masters of Music, concluding with Distinction in Performance. She has had the privilege to study with Sydney's leading piano teachers: Elizabeth Powell, Lyall Dyke and Margaret Hair. She was also a Scholarship student of Professor Lev Vlasenko (Chair of Piano, Moscow) and had the privilege to study with him during his annual visits to Australia.

During her studies, she pursued her particular interest in the piano music of Ginastera and Stravinsky. After graduating, Amanda was invited to tutor at the Conservatorium in the 'young and talented' program at the Open Academy. She was one of the inaugural teachers in the program and taught there for over a decade. During her tenure, she also tutored Chamber Music and has served on audition panels. In addition to this, Amanda was again invited to teach at the Australian Institute of Music in their 'Rising Stars' program and lectured in Performance Studies in the High School.

Amanda has a long- held interest in working in choral circles. She was rehearsal pianist for the Sydney University Graduate Choir for 12 years which saw her give many performances including Britten's Mass for St Nicolas, Orff's Carmina Burana, Carmina Cartuli and Veni Creator Spiritus, Martinu's Field Mass, and as soloist in Beethoven's Choral Fantasy and Rossini's Petite Messe Sollenelle. She has also held the position of rehearsal pianist and Chamber Organist in Sydney Grammar School's 'Bach Choir' which performed all the extant Bach Cantatas.

Amanda is passionate about the education and formation of young pianists, and devotes her working career to this. She aims to inspire each of her students in the areas of aural and intellectual creativity, technique, discipline and performance to allow her students to investigate their fullest potential. To this end, she currently holds the position of Assistant Music Master at Sydney Grammar School, examines for the AMEB as a piano examiner and runs a vibrant private practice in Sydney's North.

#### **Anne Stevens**

Anne Stevens graduated from the Canberra School of Music in 1975 and gained her DCSM (Hons) in Performance in 1977 and BA (Mus) in 1978. She studied both piano and flute and harp. Piano teacher's included Lindsay Bingham and Larry Sitsky. Her flute studies were with Margaret Crawford and David Cubbin and post-tertiary studies with Vernon Hill and Geoffrey Collins. Having attended masterclasses with Sergei Dorensky (piano) and James Galway (flute) her life-long passion for chamber music and performance was further stimulated and led her to pursue her highly successful career in chamber music and solo performance with great vigour. In conjunction with her performance was her piano teaching, with her studio always in great demand. She has performed as piano soloist with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra (Young Performers), Sydney and Canberra Youth, Maruki and Sydney Conservatorium Orchestra and as flautist and violist with the Canberra Symphony Orchestra, Canberra Opera Orchestra, Waverley Philharmonic Society, Orange Symphony, Macquarie Philharmonic and Maruki Orchestras. Anne has been a tireless and energetic advocate of chamber music and instrumental performance and played an enormous role in the development of music in the Central Western Region of NSW . Whilst establishing her professional performing profile, as a hallmark of the region. She plays regularly in Canberra as a Chamber musician in partnership with John Gould and Rita Woolhouse, runs a busy teaching and accompanying practice in Orange and currently teaches piano studies at Kinross Wolaroi School.

#### **Peggy Shen**

Peggy Shen has taught piano in high schools, as well as privately, for many years. She also teaches music theory. Ms Shen is experienced as an accompanist for instrumental exams. She is now furthering her studies for the ATMusA qualification. A member of the Australian Music Therapy Association, Ms Shen also works in the music therapy profession.
