Under the APRA AMCOS licence, competitors will not be allowed to perform without this form being filled out.

What is AMCOS?

The Australasian Mechanical Copyright Owners Society (AMCOS) ensures composers/songwriters and publishers receive royalties for the reproduction of their musical works. In turn, AMCOS provides music users to legally play, perform, copy, record and make available their members' music.

What is copyright?

Australian copyright law is legislated at a Federal level by the Australian parliament and is contained in the Commonwealth Copyright Act 1968. In simple terms, copyright is rights given to creators of original works and recordings that include exclusive rights to reproduce the material and the right to perform the work to the public. Copyright owners can prevent others from reproducing or performing their work without their permission.

Eisteddfod Prizes

Unless stated in the section, the awarded prize for each section is a trophy for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places and medals for 4th and 5th place.

General Rules and Conditions

Please Note: All rules must be read carefully to avoid disappointment and possible disqualification. Rules and conditions that apply in 2024.

APPLICATIONS

1. Please refer to the "How to Enter Online" tab for more information
2. Payments are to be made to the St. George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. Please click here for more information
3. All entries must be completed online. No entry will be accepted unless the online entry process is followed. Click here for more information.
4. An incomplete online entry will not be accepted. All sections of the online application process must be completed.
5. Entries must be submitted online no later than 1st May 2024.
6. Any late entry submitted after the 1st May 2024. Will incur an extra \$25.00 for each entry. Late entries will not be accepted after 9th May 2024.
7. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. holds no responsibility for any incorrect details submitted.
8. An entry acknowledgement receipt with your ID number for reference will be emailed to the email address provided by you. Competitors must contact if they have not received this email within 14 days of lodgement.
9. Any changes and/or corrections of details or sections WILL NOT be permitted after 9th May 2024. Competitors are advised to check all details emailed to them carefully. Any request for changes and/or corrections of details, which are the fault of the applicant, must be accompanied by a \$10.00 administration fee per each change or correction. Please check your application form thoroughly before submitting.
10. Competitors may NOT appear in section(s) other than those specified in their accepted entry form. The Committee has the right to refuse an entry.

AGE LIMITS

11. Competitors must perform in events applicable to their age only, unless an event has all ages specified. Age is determined as at 1st May 2024.
12. Events titled ANY AGE are open to anyone.
13. Events titled "Restricted" are only open to competitors who have not been placed 1st or 2nd in that Restricted section, in that particular age group, in a prior St George Instrumental Eisteddfod.

EVENTS AND PERFORMANCES

14. The adjudicator's decision is final.

15. The Convenor has the right to combine, divide sections, or reduce the number of prizes depending on the number of performing competitors. The Convenor's decision is final.

16. There must be a minimum of three (3) competitors performing in each section. In the event of fewer than 3 competitors performing, each competitor will receive an adjudication report only and no trophies or monetary prizes will be awarded.

17. Competitors must register AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE the start of the event. Competitors who fail to do so will receive adjudication reports only and will not be eligible for any trophies or monetary prizes. It is advised that when travelling to the Eisteddfod venue on competition days, each competitor should allow time for transport delays and/or parking.

18. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. accepts no responsibility for any unauthorised photocopy of music used by competitors. Please refer to the copyright laws of the Australian Commonwealth Agencies.

19. A competitor must provide at the registration table on the day of performance, a copy of the Competitor's "own choice" music for the use of the Adjudicator. PLEASE NOTE: Any photocopied music will not be returned and will be destroyed. Commercially printed sheet music provided will be returned.

20. Choosing the correct music/style according to each section's requirement as stipulated by the syllabus, is the responsibility of each competitor. Failure to present with the correct music will result in an adjudication report only. Only one (1) piece of music is allowed per section. You are not permitted to play the same piece of music in more than one section.

21. Competitors and their parents/supporters may not approach the Adjudicator's table, nor speak to the Adjudicator. If these rules are ignored, the competitor will be disqualified immediately.

22. Where a time limit is set for a performance, the competitor should not exceed it. Should this happen, the competitor is disqualified for a prize and will receive a report only.

23. Competitors in championship sections must compete in at least THREE SECTIONS in the 2024 St George Instrumental Eisteddfod, one of which is the championship itself. The pieces performed for the championship must not have been performed from the other two (2) or more sections. Any own choice piece that was performed in the heats, must be repeated in the final.

24. First place Championship winners are not permitted to enter the same section for the next two (2) years.

25. Persons who have been taught or advised by the Adjudicator in the six (6) months prior to the opening day of the Eisteddfod cannot compete in the Eisteddfod under that adjudicator.

26. Competitors waiting their turn and audience members will show consideration by remaining quiet while others are competing. If continual disruption is generated during a

performance, the offender will be asked leave the room until that particular Section has been completed.

27. Mobile phones and other electronic devices must be switched off upon entering the hall.

OTHER

28. Any child, 16 years or under, must be accompanied and supervised by an adult throughout their attendance at the event. Please contact us to receive a copy of our Child Protection Policy for more information on how our organisation protects the safety, welfare and well-being of children.

29. Copyright laws and Child Protection legal requirements prohibit private use of mobile phones, cameras, laptops, iPads, tablets and any other electronic recording devices in the competition area of the Eisteddfod venue. If a competitor's parents/supporters are found using such items any time within the performance hall, the child will be disqualified from the particular section of the competition in which they are appearing. Any offender will be asked to leave the competition area.

30. The Eisteddfod reserves the right to record, film, broadcast, telecast, videotape or photograph any entrant, item or event in the Eisteddfod without notification and any such photograph, recording or broadcast may be used at the Eisteddfod's discretion for publicity or promotional purposes, but shall not necessarily constitute an endorsement of any participants, and no remuneration or compensation whatsoever shall be attributable to any participants so featured.

31. The Eisteddfod, at its sole discretion, may promote or publicise the profile of any entrant and their participation and publish names and competition results, including photos via electronic and printed media at its discretion.

32. Personal details provided by an entrant on the entry form are for the Eisteddfod identification use only and are not released to third parties except at the Eisteddfod's discretion after consultation with the entrant to known organisations when an opportunity may be beneficial to an entrant.

33. Large bags, for example BACKPACKS, SCHOOL BAGS, INSTRUMENT CARRYING CASES ARE TO BE LEFT AT THE REGISTRATION AREA. These types of items are not permitted in the competition area of the Eisteddfod.

34. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. wishes to advise we are not responsible for any accident, injury, and/or loss of property. Please be responsible for your own personal items when attending the St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc.

35. All protests must be in writing and handed in within one hour of the completion of a section, accompanied by a fee of \$50.00. The fee is forfeited if the protest is dismissed.

36. Disruptive behaviour and/or the consumption of liquor is not acceptable nor allowed in the eisteddfod venue. This rule applies to all people who are attending the Eisteddfod venue. The offending person/people will be asked to leave immediately.

37. Admission to the competition area is to be made by Card only at the main entrance of the Kogarah School of Arts. See our website prior to attending the Eisteddfod for entry fees.

38. Competitors entering sections P202, P208, P217 and P230 are only eligible to enter one graded section only.

39. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. does not provide instruments other than the piano(s) for any section. If a competitor requires another instrument other than the piano, they must provide their own instruments.

40. Failure to comply with any of the foregoing rules and conditions may cause withholding of prizes, disqualification, and/or a future bar. The decision of the Eisteddfod in all questions or disputes arising out of or not provided for by these rules and regulations will be final. All entries are received according to this condition and in the spirit of friendly competition upon which the Eisteddfod is based, and no dispute shall become the subject of any appeal at law.

STRINGS

41. All the rules and conditions above apply to the String divisions.

42. Competitors entering sections ST311, ST325 and ST330 are only eligible to enter one graded section only.

43. Competitors who enter Open age String Concerto Championship (ST333) must compete in at THREE SECTIONS in the 2024 St George Instrumental Eisteddfod, one of which is the championship itself. The pieces performed for the championship must not have been performed from the other two (2) or more sections.

44. The first placed Open Age String Concerto Championship Winner is not permitted to enter the same section for the next two (2) years.

45. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. does not provide an official accompanist for any section. Each competitor must provide their own accompanist both for rehearsals and for the performance itself. Failure to provide an accompanist does disadvantage the performance and will result in a competitor not being considered for a prize in that section.

46. **NOTE FOR ACCOMPANISTS:** Accompanists are entitled free entry only if an application to the Convenor is received by email - one month prior to the opening day of the St George Instrumental Eisteddfod.

Copyright

It is important that all competitors and teachers realise their responsibility regarding laws under the *Australian Copyright Act 1968*. The following are the conditions under which printed material can be used at this Eisteddfod.

Adjudicator's copy

- a. Own Choice, the competitor must supply the Adjudicator with a photocopy. The original is to be used by the competitor for the performance and the Eisteddfod Committee will destroy the copy immediately after adjudication.
- b. For Set Pieces, the Adjudicator must work from an original

Competitor's copy

If the competitor is not performing from memory, an original or licensed photocopy must be used in the performance. This original can be borrowed from a library, friend or another competitor.

New rulings on accompanists copy (AMCOS)

The following conditions must be met before a photocopy can be made for an accompanist:

- The accompaniment part must be printed on the same page as the solo instrumental or vocal part(s) i.e. inseparable from the solo part.
- A single photocopy of the accompaniment may be made for use in a performance such as an Eisteddfod.
- Single copy must be marked with the words "Accompanist Copy"
- After the performance, the copy of the accompaniment must be handed to the Eisteddfod organisation for collection and all these copies sent to AMCOS at the conclusion of the Eisteddfod.

Child protection

In the interest of protecting children, the St. George Eisteddfod Inc requests that photographs and videos of children not be taken in the area of competition.

To take photographs and / or videos is considered to be an invasion of privacy and the person doing so may be in breach of the Privacy Laws of both the Commonwealth of Australia and The NSW Government Laws within the Privacy Act.

Adjudicators

Evan Elsley

Violinist Evan Elsley, a university scholarship recipient, studied Violin at Sydney University and at the Sydney and Warsaw Conservatoriums. He has held Director of String positions in England, Australia and teaches at tertiary level. Evan is regularly asked to adjudicate Eisteddfods and conduct workshops. His students have won numerous scholarships, been awarded diplomas, degrees and have entered the profession. As a performer he works as a soloist and ensemble leader. His concert engagements for organizations including the ABC, Musica Viva, Sydney Festival, Conservatoriums and Arts Councils have received critical press acclaim. World premieres include works by major Australasian composers. Recordings have been on EMI, Festival, Larrikin, K Tel labels and his TV credits range through numerous midday and morning shows, ABC Music Specials, soaps, films. He has played in pop videos and commercials for both the local and international markets.

He has been booked to entertain other musicians and their promotional organisations, which include Elton John, Moscow Ballet, Australian Ballet, Royal Amsterdam, Melbourne and Sydney Symphony Orchestras

Mr. Elsley B.A. is an Examiner in String Instruments for the AMEB (NSW).

Gina Henery

After completing Year 12 at the Conservatorium High School, Gina Henery studied at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music before moving to London to further her violin studies.

While in the United Kingdom, Mrs Henery was a regular performer with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra and the Philharmonia Orchestra. She held a full-time first violin position with the English National Ballet. Since returning to Australia in 1998, she has worked with the Australian Opera and Ballet Orchestra and is a regular player and director of the Sydney Scoring Orchestra. She has recorded notable movie soundtracks, including Happy Feet, Australia and Mad Max: Fury Road.

For many years, Mrs Henery was a violin teacher and tutor at St Andrew's Cathedral School. She was also a regular performer and chamber music tutor at the Riverina Summer School for Strings. Mrs Henery tutored the East Lindfield Primary School String Ensemble, which she conducted in numerous competitions.

In addition to her performing and examining commitments, Mrs Henery teaches string students at her private studio in Sydney.

Michael Bardon

Accelerated into university at age 17, Michael Bardon holds degrees from the Musichochschule Luebeck and Johannes Gutenberg Universitaet Mainz in Germany, the University of Newcastle in Australia and gained professional orchestral training as an academy graduate of the Essen Philharmonic Orchestra in Germany. His principal teachers include Professors Diethelm Jonas, Nick Deutsch and Anthea Scott-Mitchell, leading to a unique skill set holding Master's degrees in both cello and oboe performance and an extensive knowledge of repertoire and ensemble playing. He performs as solo, chamber and orchestral musician including engagement in the Essen Philharmonic, Frankfurt Opera, Sinfonietta Baltica, Orchester M18, Sydney Philharmonia, The Orchestra Project and the Willoughby Symphony. An experienced teacher, Michael is dedicated to assisting students to reach their potential and worked in academic leadership as Program Leader of Classical Performance at the Australian Institute of Music from 2017 – 2020, which included guest lecturing at the University of Shanghai. Commencing 2021 he joined the Darwin Symphony as Principal Cellist, performing major symphonic works of Beethoven, Tchaikovsky, Shostakovich, Holst, Brahms and notable Australian music engagement including the demanding solo cello role for Gurrumul's Bunggul in collaboration with Erkki Veltheim and Veronique Serret, and as cello soloist for the 2022 premiere of the Olive Pink opera by Anne Boyd. Michael is a member of the Arafura Music Collective for whom he recently performed Bach's third cello suite, and as soloist and director for the Haydn C major cello concerto.
