ALL MUSIC to be performed throughout the Eisteddfod is to be listed on this one form. The form may be downloaded via the link below and One Music Australia site.

Under the APRA AMCOS licence, competitors will not be allowed to perform without this form being filled out.

What is AMCOS?

The Australasian Mechanical Copyright Owners Society (AMCOS) ensures composers/songwriters and publishers receive royalties for the reproduction of their musical works. In turn, AMCOS provides music users to legally play, perform, copy, record and make available their members' music.

What is copyright?

Australian copyright law is legislated at a Federal level by the Australian parliament and is contained in the Commonwealth Copyright Act 1968. In simple terms, copyright is rights given to creators of original works and recordings that include exclusive rights to reproduce the material and the right to perform the work to the public. Copyright owners can prevent others from reproducing or performing their work without their permission.

General Rules and Conditions

Please Note: All rules must be read carefully to avoid disappointment and possible disqualification. Rules and conditions that apply in 2026.

APPLICATIONS

1. Please refer to the "How to Enter Online" tab for more information
2. Payments are to be made to the St. George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. Please click [here](#) for more information
3. All entries must be completed online. No entry will be accepted unless the online entry process is followed. Click [here](#) for more information.
4. An incomplete online entry will not be accepted. All sections of the online application process must be completed.
5. Entries must be submitted online no later than 30th April 2026.
6. Any late entry submitted after the 30th April 2026, will incur an extra \$25.00 for each entry. Late entries will not be accepted after 7th May 2026.
7. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. holds no responsibility for any incorrect details submitted.
8. An entry acknowledgement receipt with your ID number for reference will be emailed from info@stgie.org to the email address provided by you. Competitors must contact if they have not received this email within 14 days of lodgement.
9. Any changes and/or corrections of details or sections WILL NOT be permitted after 7th May 2026. Competitors are advised to check all details emailed to them carefully. Any request for changes and/or corrections of details, which are the fault of the applicant, must be accompanied by a \$10.00 administration fee per each change or correction. Please check your application form thoroughly before submitting.
10. Competitors may NOT appear in section(s) other than those specified in their accepted entry form. The Committee has the right to refuse an entry.

AGE LIMITS

11. Competitors must perform in events applicable to their age only, unless an event has all ages specified. Age is determined as at 30th April 2026.
12. Events titled ANY AGE are open to anyone.
13. Events titled "Restricted" are only open to competitors who have not been placed 1st or 2nd in that Restricted section, in that particular age group, in a prior St George Instrumental Eisteddfod.

EVENTS AND PERFORMANCES

14. The adjudicator's decision is final.

15. The Convenor has the right to combine, divide sections, or reduce the number of prizes depending on the number of performing competitors. The Convenor's decision is final.
16. There must be a minimum of three (3) competitors performing in each section. In the event of fewer than 3 competitors performing, each competitor will receive an adjudication report only and no trophies or monetary prizes will be awarded.
17. Competitors must register AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE the start of the event. Competitors who fail to do so will receive adjudication reports only and will not be eligible for any trophies or monetary prizes. It is advised that when travelling to the Eisteddfod venue on competition days, each competitor should allow time for transport delays and/or parking.
18. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. accepts no responsibility for any unauthorised photocopy of music used by competitors. Please refer to the copyright laws of the Australian Commonwealth Agencies.
19. A competitor must provide at the registration table on the day of performance, a copy of the Competitor's "own choice" music for the use of the Adjudicator. PLEASE NOTE: Any photocopied music will not be returned and will be destroyed. Commercially printed sheet music provided will be returned.
20. Choosing the correct music/style according to each section's requirement as stipulated by the syllabus, is the responsibility of each competitor. Failure to present with the correct music will result in an adjudication report only. Only one (1) piece of music is allowed per section. You are not permitted to play the same piece of music in more than one section.
21. Competitors and their parents/supporters may not approach the Adjudicator's table, nor speak to the Adjudicator. If these rules are ignored, the competitor will be disqualified immediately.
22. Where a time limit is set for a performance, the competitor should not exceed it. Should this happen, the competitor is disqualified for a prize and will receive a report only.
23. Competitors in championship sections must compete in at least THREE SECTIONS in the 2026 St George Instrumental Eisteddfod, one of which is the championship itself. The pieces performed for the championship must not have been performed from the other two (2) or more sections. Any own choice piece that was performed in the heats, must be repeated in the final.
24. Where there are fewer than 10 entries in a heat, the conduct of that heat will be subject to the convenor's discretion as to how, or whether, the heat will proceed.
25. First place Championship winners are not permitted to enter the same section for the next two (2) years.
26. Persons who have been taught or advised by the Adjudicator in the six (6) months prior to the opening day of the Eisteddfod cannot compete in the Eisteddfod under that adjudicator.

27. Competitors waiting their turn and audience members will show consideration by remaining quiet while others are competing. If continual disruption is generated during a performance, the offender will be asked leave the room until that particular Section has been completed.

28. Mobile phones and other electronic devices must be switched off upon entering the hall.

OTHER

29. Any child, 16 years or under, must be accompanied and supervised by an adult throughout their attendance at the event. Please contact us to receive a copy of our Child Protection Policy for more information on how our organisation protects the safety, welfare and well-being of children.

30. Copyright laws and Child Protection legal requirements prohibit private use of mobile phones, cameras, laptops, iPads, tablets and any other electronic recording devices in the competition area of the Eisteddfod venue. If a competitor's parents/supporters are found using such items any time within the performance hall, the child will be disqualified from the particular section of the competition in which they are appearing. Any offender will be asked to leave the competition area.

31. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Committee and volunteers provides a child safe culture by supporting children and young people, their parents, guardians, families and communities, and by ensuring all staff and volunteers who work with St George Instrumental Eisteddfod are committed to safeguarding children and young people. We refer to our Child Protection Policy. Accordingly, St George Instrumental Eisteddfod will ensure that all stakeholders of the organisation know how and when to report any concerns, complaints or allegations of concerning conduct, including abuse, neglect or grooming. "Complaint" means any suggestion of abuse or harm that is disclosed, witnessed or demonstrated by a child. Typically, three categories of behaviour are the subject of a complaint: "concerning conduct": behaviours or patterns of behaviour that are a risk to the safety of children. This also refers to ambiguous behaviours that are potentially inappropriate for children to be exposed to but may not necessarily be indicators of abuse occurring. The sharing of inappropriate jokes may be an example of this; "misconduct": behaviour that constitutes a breach of the organisation's Child Safe Code of Conduct; and "criminal conduct": conduct that, if proven, would constitute a criminal offence. Any of the above conduct is not acceptable nor allowed in the Eisteddfod venue. This rule applies to all people who are attending the Eisteddfod venue. The offending person/people will be asked to leave immediately and/or appropriate authorities will be notified.

32. The Eisteddfod reserves the right to record, film, broadcast, telecast, videotape or photograph any entrant, item or event in the Eisteddfod without notification and any such photograph, recording or broadcast may be used at the Eisteddfod's discretion for publicity or promotional purposes, but shall not necessarily constitute an endorsement of any participants, and no remuneration or compensation whatsoever shall be attributable to any participants so featured.

33. The Eisteddfod, at its sole discretion, may promote or publicise the profile of any entrant and their participation and publish names and competition results, including photos via electronic and printed media at its discretion.

34. Personal details provided by an entrant on the entry form are for the Eisteddfod identification use only and are not released to third parties except at the Eisteddfod's

discretion after consultation with the entrant to known organisations when an opportunity may be beneficial to an entrant.

35. Large bags, for example BACKPACKS, SCHOOL BAGS, INSTRUMENT CARRYING CASES ARE TO BE LEFT AT THE REGISTRATION AREA. These types of items are not permitted in the competition area of the Eisteddfod.

36. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. wishes to advise we are not responsible for any accident, injury, and/or loss of property. Please be responsible for your own personal items when attending the St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc.

37. All protests must be in writing and handed in within one hour of the completion of a section, accompanied by a fee of \$50.00. The fee is forfeited if the protest is dismissed.

38. Disruptive behaviour and/or the consumption of liquor is not acceptable nor allowed in the Eisteddfod venue. This rule applies to all people who are attending the Eisteddfod venue. The offending person/people will be asked to leave immediately.

39. Admission to the competition area is to be made by Card only at the main entrance of the Kogarah School of Arts. See our website prior to attending the Eisteddfod for entry fees.

40. Competitors entering sections P202, P208, P217 and P230 are only eligible to enter one graded section only.

41. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. does not provide instruments other than the piano(s) for any section. If a competitor requires another instrument other than the piano, they must provide their own instruments.

42. Failure to comply with any of the foregoing rules and conditions may cause withholding of prizes, disqualification, and/or a future bar. The decision of the Eisteddfod in all questions or disputes arising out of or not provided for by these rules and regulations will be final. All entries are received according to this condition and in the spirit of friendly competition upon which the Eisteddfod is based, and no dispute shall become the subject of any appeal at law.

STRINGS

43. All the rules and conditions above apply to the String divisions.

44. Competitors entering sections ST311, ST323 and ST327 are only eligible to enter one graded section only.

45. Competitors who enter Open age String Concerto Championship (ST330) must compete in at THREE SECTIONS in the 2026 St George Instrumental Eisteddfod, one of which is the championship itself. The pieces performed for the championship must not have been performed from the other two (2) or more sections.

46. The first placed Open Age String Concerto Championship Winner is not permitted to enter the same section for the next two (2) years.

47. The St George Instrumental Eisteddfod Inc. does not provide an official accompanist for any section. Each competitor must provide their own accompanist both for rehearsals and for the performance itself. Failure to provide an accompanist does disadvantage the performance and will result in a competitor not being considered for a prize in that section.

48. NOTE FOR ACCOMPANISTS: Accompanists are entitled free entry only if an application to the Convenor is received by email - one month prior to the opening day of the St George Instrumental Eisteddfod.

Copyright

It is important that all contestants and teachers realise their responsibility regarding laws under the *Australian Copyright Act 1968*. The following are the conditions under which printed material can be used at this Eisteddfod.

Adjudicator's Copy

- Own Choice, the competitor must supply the Adjudicator with a photocopy. The original is to be used by the competitor for the performance and the Eisteddfod Committee will destroy the copy immediately after adjudication.
- For Set Pieces, the Adjudicator must work from an original.

Competitor's Copy

If the competitor is not performing from memory, an original or licensed photocopy must be used in the performance. This original can be borrowed from a library, friend or another competitor.

New Rulings on Accompanist's Copy (AMCOS)

The following conditions must be met before a photocopy can be made for an accompanist:

- The accompaniment part must be printed on the same page as the solo instrumental or vocal part(s) i.e. inseparable from the solo part.
- A single photocopy of the accompaniment may be made for use in a performance such as an Eisteddfod.
- Single copy must be marked with the words "Accompanist Copy".

After the performance, the copy of the accompaniment must be handed to the Eisteddfod Organisation for collection and all these copies sent to AMCOS at the conclusion of the Eisteddfod.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES PERMITTED WITHIN THE PERFORMANCE HALL.

Rules:

- **NO PHOTOGRAPHY**
- **NO PHONES**
- **NO VIDEOS**
- **NO COMPUTERS**

The use of any camera, mobile phone, video camera, computer, or any other electronic device is strictly prohibited.

This rule applies to all attendees of the Eisteddfod.

Volunteers of the Eisteddfod acting in their official capacity may be excepted.

Any person found using such a device will have the device temporarily confiscated, and if the recording or use of the device relates to a participant, that participant will be immediately disqualified from the section they are performing in the Eisteddfod.

Adjudicators

Amanda Miller - MMus, BMus (Piano Perf)

Amanda Miller, based in Sydney, NSW, AU, is currently a Private Piano Studio at Piano Teacher. Amanda Miller brings experience from previous roles at Knox Grammar School, NSW Department of Education and Communities and Sydney Grammar School. Amanda Miller holds a Masters of Music, Bachelor of Music in Piano Performance at Sydney Conservatorium of Music. With a robust skill set that includes Pianist, Choral, Chamber Music, Composition, Tutoring and more.

Coady Green

One of Australia's busiest concert pianists, Coady Green is acknowledged as a major talent on the international concert circuit, described as "a virtuoso pianist with sensitivity, intelligence and charm", "accurate and exhilarating" (Musical Opinion, London), and with "a strong and versatile technique capable of the most delicate coloring and tonal brilliance, rising to the challenges of extreme virtuoso demands with relish" (The Advertiser, South Australia).

In 2005, Coady relocated from Melbourne to London after winning almost all the most prestigious awards that his native Australia had to offer, including first prize in the City of Sydney National Piano Competition, a Winston Churchill Fellowship Award, a British Council Award, the Trevor Prescott Memorial Award from the Masonic Foundation, a Sir Ian Potter Cultural Prize, two awards from the Australian Council for the Arts and the South Australian Arts Council, and the Ormond Exhibition from the University of Melbourne.

Coady was a lecturer in classical performance and staff piano teacher at Goldsmiths College, The University of London, and a piano teacher at the Royal College of Music, London. He now teaches piano and lectures on the performance staff at the Melbourne Conservatorium of Music, The University of Melbourne. He frequently gives masterclasses within Europe and the USA.

Dr. Jerard Heffernan - MM, BMus, LMusA, AMusA

Dr. Jerard Heffernan studied at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music with Sonya Hanke, earning a Bachelor of Music with high distinction.

After winning numerous piano scholarships and competitions, Dr. Heffernan travelled to the United States. He completed a Master of Music in piano performance at the prestigious Peabody Institute, where he won the school's Memorial Award for outstanding achievement. He was taught at that time by Julian Martin and Marc Durand, while also participating in masterclasses with Leon Fleisher, Vladimir Feltsman and Ann Schein.

Dr Heffernan has participated in many international festivals, including in Aspen, Calgary, Banff and Orford. He recently visited the Juilliard School of Music in New York, where he attended lessons and doctoral seminars.

In Australia, Dr Heffernan has taught piano at all levels, including at the Newcastle Conservatorium and the Australian Institute of Music.

Ross Hamilton - BMus, MMus (MusEd), AMusA, LMusA

Ross Hamilton is a graduate of Sydney University, where he studied piano with Margaret Hair and music education with Peter Dunbar-Hall. His research interests included piano music by Australian composers and music education for gifted and talented students.

Mr Hamilton has performed with many leading instrumental and vocal soloists and ensembles, including the Carlson Chorale, the Hills Chamber Ensemble and the Coruscations contemporary music ensemble. He has also performed in radio broadcasts and music club recitals, including at the Federated Music Clubs, the Aulos Society and the Australian Musicians Academy. Mr Hamilton has participated in premier performances of works by Kirsty Beilharz, Miriam Hyde, Miloslav Penicka, Paul Stanhope and Stephen Yates. For more than 10 years, he was an official accompanist for the Sydney Eisteddfod.

In addition to his private studio, Mr Hamilton has taught at Barker College, Knox Grammar School, Newington College, the Sydney Conservatorium and the Australian Institute of Music. His teaching philosophy draws together various strands of current piano pedagogy, with the aim of developing a relaxed technique, sound intellectual understanding, and personal self-expression. He has extensively analysed many of the pieces in the AMEB syllabus in order to promote greater understanding of the background and essential musical elements of the works.

Mr Hamilton has been an adjudicator for Ryde Eisteddfod and the NSW Music Teachers' Association. He was a church pianist for many years and has also performed as a soloist and accompanist at nursing home concerts.

Sarah Jameson - MMus, BMus (Hons), AmusA

Cellist Sarah Jameson completed her bachelor's and master's degrees at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, having studied with Dorothy Sumner and Georg Pedersen. Her master's thesis was on the topic of cello pedagogy.

Mrs Jameson has an active career as a performer and chamber musician. Since 2013, she has been Principal Cellist with the Willoughby Symphony Orchestra. Between 2010 and 2016, she toured with Musica Viva. Mrs Jameson plays regularly with local ensembles and for community and school events.

In addition to performing, Mrs Jameson has taught privately and at schools including Barker College and Loreto Normanhurst. She has composed and arranged extensively for youth string orchestras and has initiated and developed string programs in schools. As a teacher, she is committed to providing students with a solid technical foundation while fostering their enthusiasm and love of playing.
